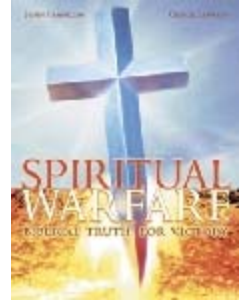

### Spiritual Warfare: Biblical Truth for Victory

Much controversy in spiritual warfare revolves around seeking to gain an upper hand on the enemy in order to defeat him. How much power does Satan actually have? Can he invade my life at any moment and wreck havoc? Where is God during Satan's attack? Is God really in charge?

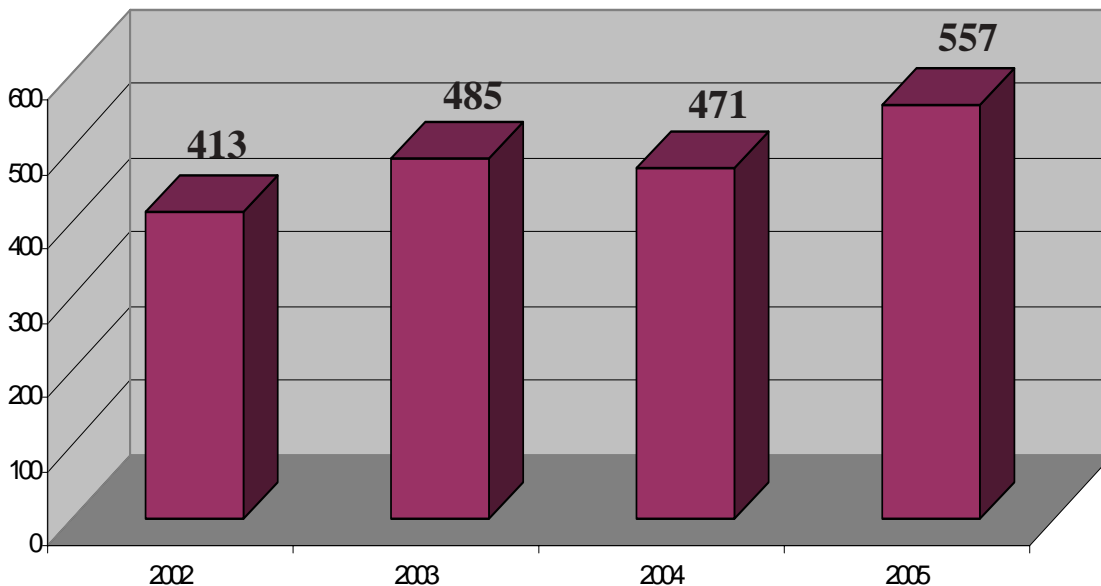


you are able to do any of these three things, consider going. The date for the trip is August 13-19th. Cost will be \$500 and will include housing, one meal

# Jr. High Students Take Spring Break Mission Trip to Northern Indiana



On April 1<sup>st</sup>, fourteen 6th-8th grade students along with eleven adults left Northside Baptist Church, Indianapolis to spend the weekend in Medaryville, Indiana. As the students tumbled out of vans, they were greeted by the joyful Rev. Buck Jackson and his wife Lynn, who had made biscuits, gravy and hash browns for their guests' evening treat.

Pastor Buck and Lynn were saved at the Medaryville property they purchased and developed into Leisure Time Park 12 years ago. The park is now "Leisure Time Gospel Park" where it

is doubtful that anyone can come without hearing the good news about Jesus. The Jackson's hold a bluegrass sing-along on Saturday evenings and have a motor cross race track where hundreds of visitors gather for races several times each year. The Lord uses the Jacksons' gift of hospitality to give His love and help to released prisoners, homeless people or anyone who finds themselves in a difficult place in life.

Tony Manning, Minister to Students, challenged the junior-high and middle-school students at Northside to "taste" missions with a weekend commitment April 1-3rd, the weekend between the area schools' spring breaks. Fourteen students responded and prepared by memorizing six Scripture verses and turning in sermon notes, as well as writing out their testimonies.



Saturday, April 2<sup>nd</sup> the students and adults helped clear brush from wooded areas of Leisure Time Gospel Park by picking up sticks. Concerned that the students have a good time, Pastor Buck insisted they take time to play, so there were several games of touch football before and after picking up sticks.

That evening the mission team joined blue grass singers who gathered from near and far to sing gospel songs. Sunday, the students worshiped with Leisure Time Baptist Church in the

same lodge. The students were among those who offered songs of praise from the platform and Tony preached the message.



As they discussed their weekend experience, the students said they were all glad they came. One girl stated, "I never thought I would want to go on a mission trip, but after this weekend I think I will be interested in going."

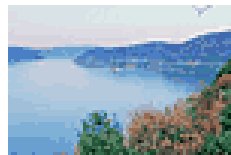
## Sr. Adult Luncheon & Hymn Sing
