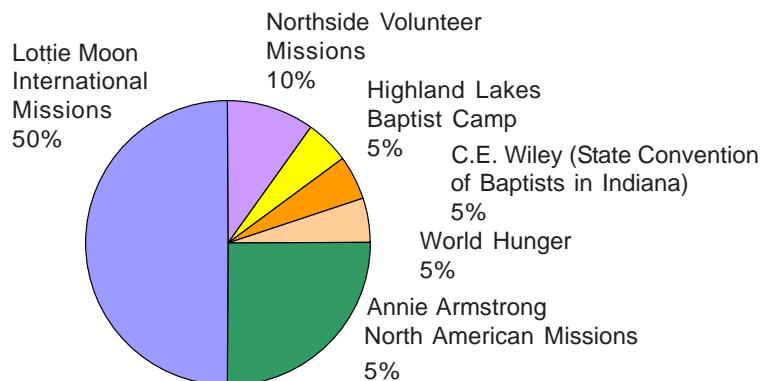
Be involved in all aspects of fulfilling the Acts 1:8 challenge by committing to give sacrificially to the B.J. Higgins Mission Fund throughout the year.
